A LIVING WILL

A Living Will, also called an "Advanced Care Directive", sets forth your personal wishes regarding your medical care. The standard lowa State Bar Association form essentially states that in the event you have a terminal condition and are no expected to live very long, your health care provider shall not use artificial life support to keep you alive.

There are other variations of the living will. We can provide you with alternatives and discuss your choices.
